2010 Auction Fee Schedule

Basic Entry Fee:

Prior to January 15th - \$750

After January 15th - \$1000

This fee covers the inclusion in our Auction Catalog and our marketing and presentation of your horse. *(Please also note "Seller's Responsibility" section regarding submission of photos and DVD footage)* This fee must be paid upon the signing of the Auction Contract at the time of your horse's acceptance. This check should be payable to InterContinental Sport Horse Sales, LLC. *Once the horse is accepted as an Auction Horse and included in our Auction Catalog, this fee is non-refundable.*

Stall Fee, Boarding, and Day Care:

\$900

Flat fee for up to ten days prior to auction date.

This fee covers tented area stall use at our farm for up to two weeks prior to auction date. This fee also includes all grooming care, hay, feed, shavings, riding and training as needed and presentation of the horse to potential bidders prior to the auction event. Your horse will also be presented in a professional manner for the day of the auction.

This fee is payable to InterContinental Sport Horse Sales, LLC prior to arrival date.

Horses boarded before the "ten days prior" date or after "48 hours post-auction" are subject to the prevailing Florida boarding rates in place at the Ridge Farm, LLC and will be billed at the rate of \$100 per day plus stall rental fee at a rate of \$250 per week.

Vet Fees (*):

\$350 (includes \$50 initial review of x-rays)

A limited "pre-purchase" type exam must be performed on horse upon arrival to auction site. The exam must be performed by our staff vet, Dr. Brendon Furlong, or one of his staff associates within the 2 week period preceding the auction date. This fee **MUST** be paid via Credit Card or Bank Check to "Brendon Furlong and Associates" upon arrival to the auction site.

Additional Fees:

Additional fees may include, but are not limited to:

farrier fees, body clipping (\$150 if needed), additional vet fees if incurred, medications, etc. which will be billed and are payable at time of service.

Photographing and DVD Footage:

In order for us to market and present your horse in the best manner possible, you should be prepared to provide us with photographs that are suitable for use in our Auction Catalogue as well as use on our web site. Any permission required by the photographer to use the photograph will be the responsibility of the consigner/seller. Photo credit will be given. If photos are not available or are not suitable for our use, we will have our staff photographer generate a standard "standing" shot of your horse for a fee of \$50. (Please keep in mind, that we may not then have time to include the photo in the auction catalogue, but will use for web site marketing.) In addition, please be prepared to provide us with DVD performance footage of your horse for marketing use as well. If footage is not available, our DVD crew will do their best to obtain suitable footage for a fee of \$150.
